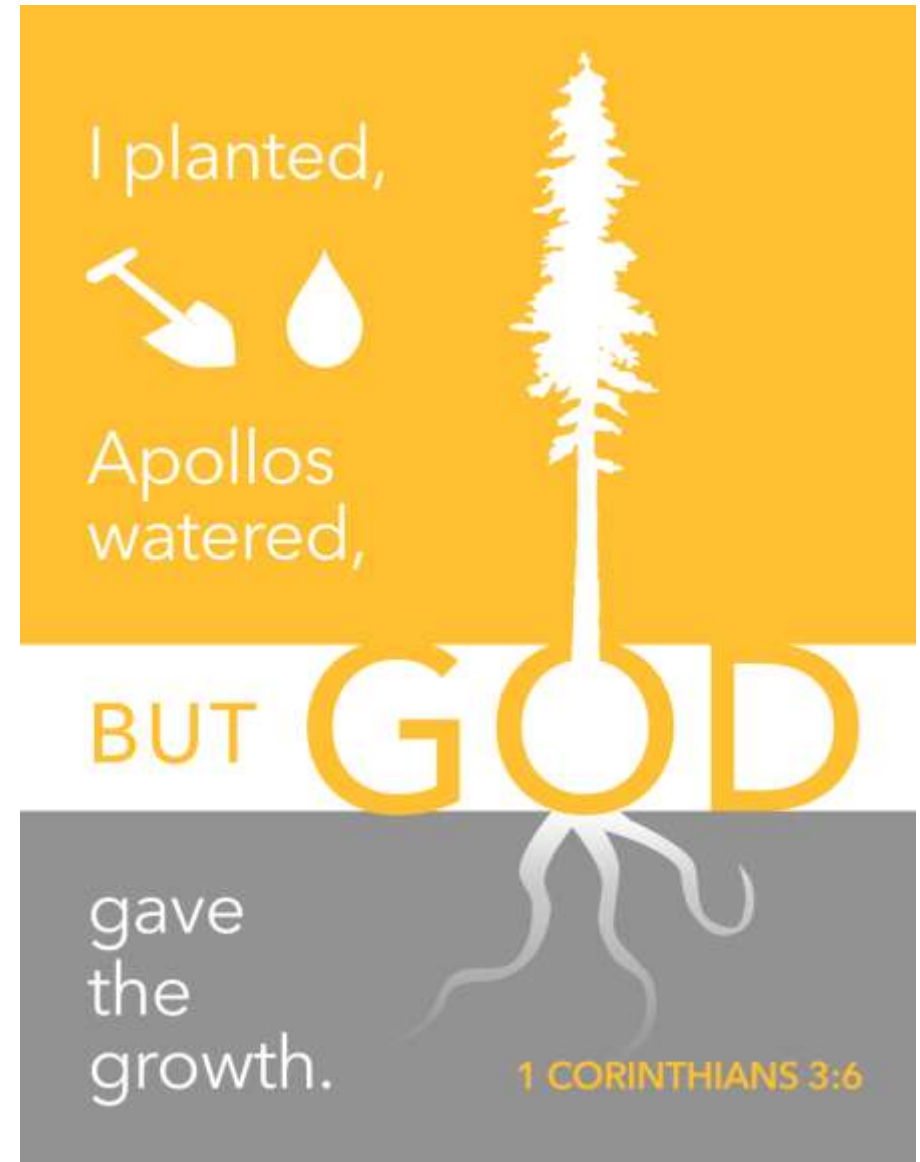
TALENT SHOW Mark Friday, March 7th on your calendar as our 2014 Talent Show - "On The Radio" showcases TUMC Talent.
