PRAYER SHAWL We will meet this Tuesday at 6:30. All are welcome to join!

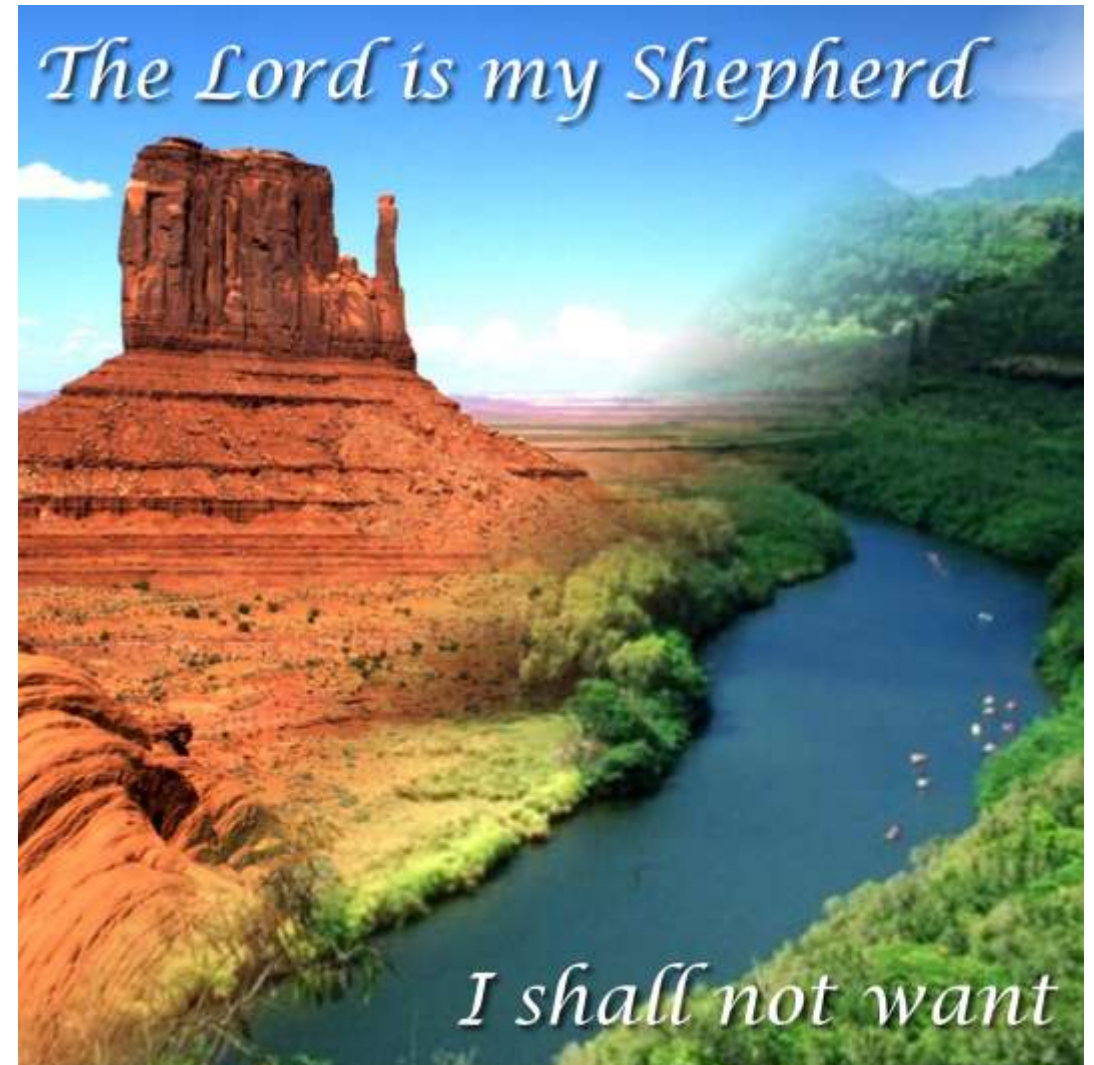
WOMEN'S SKIT REHEARSAL We will meet tomorrow (Mon, Apr 7) at 6 pm.
