PRAYER CARDS A group will meet this Wednesday morning at 10 am to make prayer cards. All are welcome to join us.

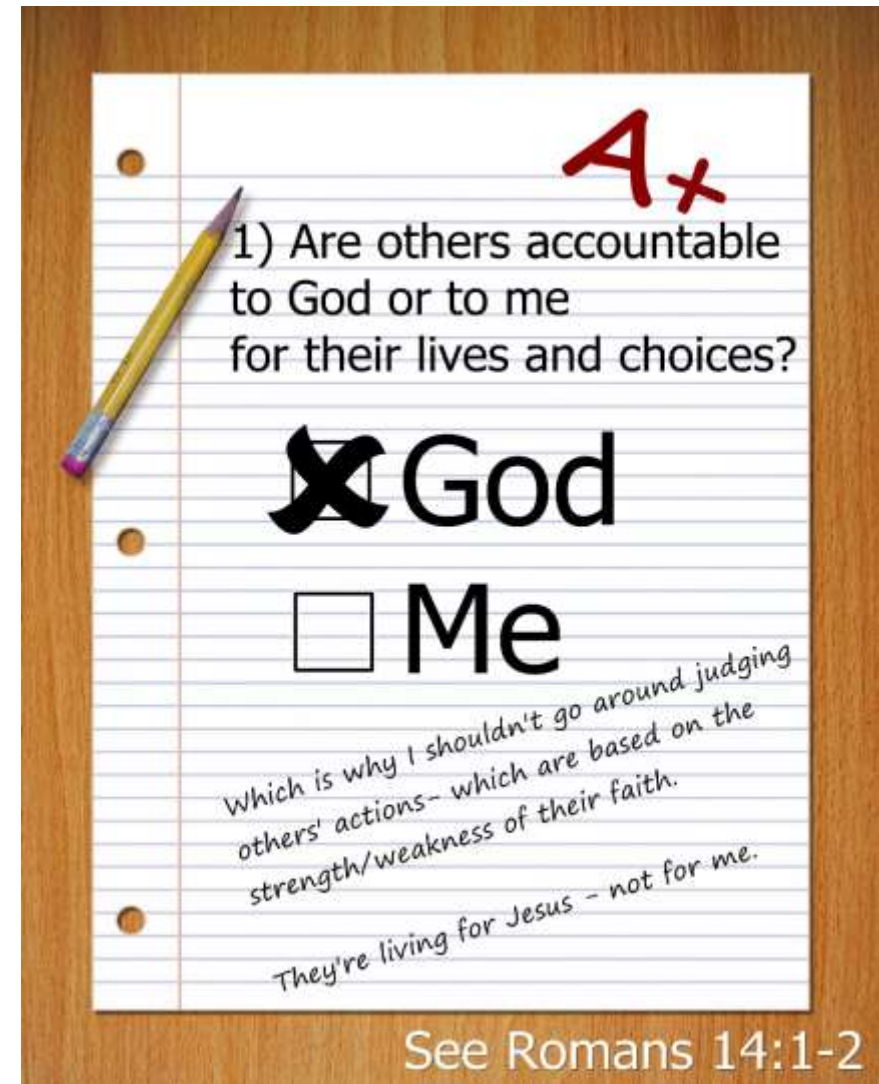
ADMINISTRATIVE COUNCIL The next scheduled meeting of the Trinity Administrative Council is this Thursday at 7 pm in Classroom 2.
