SPR STAFF PARISH RELATIONS SPR will meet today at 2 pm.

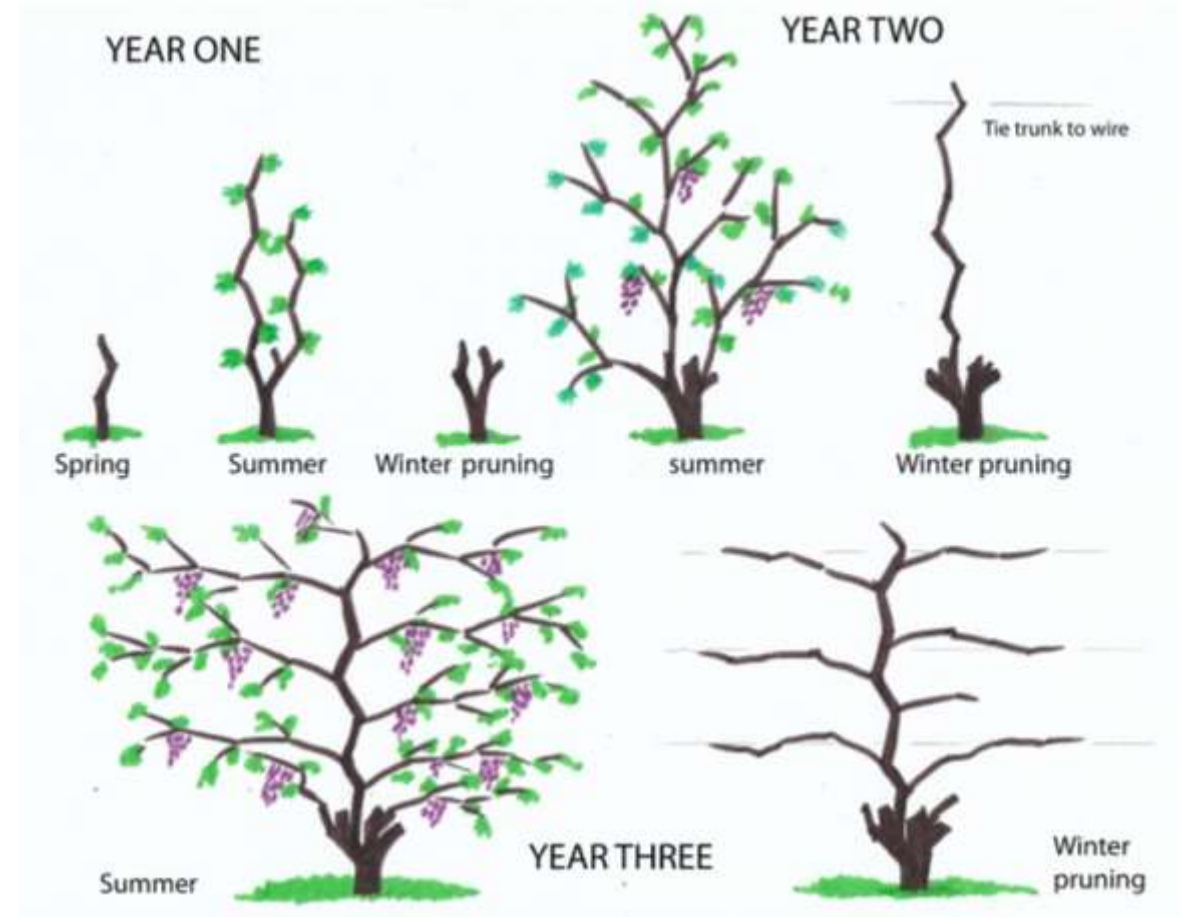
