UMFS We will meet at 5:15 this Friday, July 31 to go to United Methodist Family Services. Talk to Deborah for more information.

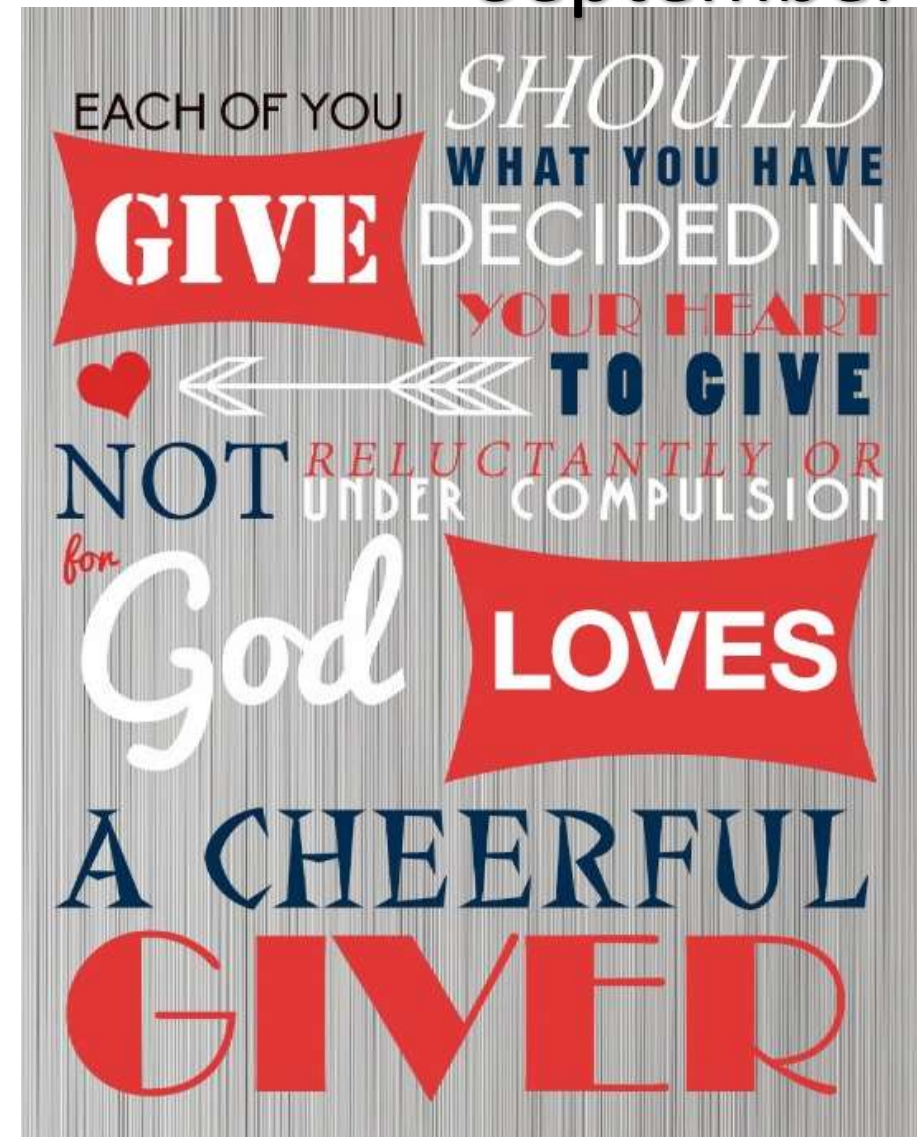
