

Exciting Security Update for Our Church Building

We're happy to share that the Leadership Board is enhancing our building's security to help keep our church a safe and welcoming place for all. Beginning the first week of April, we'll be upgrading from traditional key locks to a modern **electronic entry system** on all exterior doors.

This new system offers more flexibility and convenience! Once the upgrade is complete, your current keys will no longer work. Instead, building access will be available through three designated entry points: the kitchen door, the music department door, and the administration door. All three can be accessed with a **Key Fob**, and the administration door will also feature a **keypad** for entry with a personal PIN.

One of the great benefits of this system is that we can **pre-program access** for scheduled events. For example, on Wednesday evenings, the doors can automatically open during designated times for children's ministry, youth activities, and choir practice—no need to manage keys or worry about unlocking the doors!

We appreciate your patience and cooperation as we make this transition. If you need access for a particular project or event, please reach out to **Emilee in the office**. A great time to stop by is during office hours: **Tuesday-Thursday**, **9:30 AM to 1:00 PM**.
